


The “Golden Triangle” of poverty eradication



Preventive Healthcare

- **Fighting intestinal diseases**
 - Construction of a latrine for each family, its proper use and cleanliness
 - Control of intestinal parasites, especially in children and dogs, with traditional medicine and medication from the Ministry of Health
 - Order and cleanliness in and around the house.
 - Drinking water: Coverage, management, maintenance and regular disinfection
- **Fighting bronco-pulmonary disease**
 - Construction of an improved stove for each family, with chimneys that effectively evacuate all smoke from the living area. (the stove should also save on firewood)
- **Fighting malnutrition**
 - Monthly control of nutritional status of all children (by the community health volunteer of the Ministry of Health, providing leaflets and required equipment
 - Production and diversification of food production by each family (vegetables, fruits, milk, small animals, fish, eggs)
- **Other relevant issues in human health**
 - Improve the performance of the community health volunteer of the Ministry of Health
 - Increase access to the services of the Ministry of Health, demanding of all participants the regular use of the services provided, such as:
 - Regular Pre- and postnatal control
 - Family Planning, etc.
 - Vaccinations of all family members
 - Combat alcoholism
 - Combat family violence
 - Waste management


Education

- **Adult literacy rate**
 - The existence of a literacy program for adults
 - Periodic testing of writing and understanding of texts
 - Percentage of the literate population
- **School attendance** (5 10 18 years)
 - School attendance of all school-aged children
 - Periodic testing of writing and understanding of texts
 - Control of Assistance of teachers
 - Existence and maintenance of the school and its equipment

Cultural Aspects

“Education”, as defined in the Human Development Index, is just one aspect of a much wider issue: culture and cultural identity. This is the central issue our golden triangle, and is the motor that makes Pachamama Raymi function as it does.

Family income

- 
- Improving rangeland management (by which extensive and eroded grazing areas can be reclaimed)
 - Reforestation (can only be successful in combination with improved rangeland management)
 - Improving field irrigation and management of irrigation systems
 - Soil conservation
 - Improved breeding of small animals (chicken, guinea pigs, bees, fish)
 - Improved animal husbandry (cows, sheep, pigs, horses, etc.)
 - Improved care and use of animal manure, production of humus and compost
 - Improved production of seeds of all crops
 - Improved and diversified vegetable garden
 - Introduction of native and exotic species (alfalfa, ryegrass, clover, etc.) during fallow
 - Reforestation (fruit trees, fire wood and valuable wood species)
 - Reclamation of grazing areas
 - Improvement of housing and other investments in individual infrastructure
 - Stimulate associations
 - Family businesses (transformation of harvests into more valuable products, tourism, handicrafts, etc.).
